1. Remove the engine control unit under the driver's seat and open the cover by carefully bending up the clips.



2. Carefully loosen the upper circuit board from the fastening (1) and lever out the locking lugs (2) on the left and right to secure the circuit board (3). push it backwards and unfold it.








Technical bulletin

In order to cover the various legal country regulations and vehicle variants, the corresponding corresponding maps are integrated in the DME control unit. These can be read directly with the system tester 9288 under the menu item "Actual values".

Do not carry out any system configuration with the system tester!





To call up these characteristic diagrams, a 2-pole and a 3-pole stretch connection are made within the DME cable harness. These are bridged/ connected differently depending on the country version.

To run the CARGRAPHIC MAF Sensor Kit, all coding connections must be disconnected!

5. Remove air filter and air flow meter

- open the 4 clamps of the air filter box and remove the box the 4 fastening
 remove from air box
- Remove the vacuum line from the vacuum accumulator and the box Remove
- Loosen the hose clamp on the air flow meter and remove the plug



6. Installation wiring harness

Connect the red cable to the plug of the MAF sensor thread through the cable duct and attach it to the existing red cable in the wiring harness. Close the connection carefully.

7. installing air filter kit:

- Set the MAF sensor with the air filter in the inlet hose and bring it in the right position
- screw the bracket of the filter on the manifold
- plug in the connction of the MAF sensor
- reconnect the ventilation hose
- tighten the clamp

Attach the ground connection with the enclosed screw under the rubber buffer on the intake manifold.
